

2026 Youth Pig Project Scholarship

The Wisconsin Pork Association Youth Committee is again offering Youth Pig Project scholarships. These scholarships are designed to assist 4-H and FFA members in establishing swine projects that can lead to development of life skills and career opportunities in the Wisconsin pork industry. As part of our mission, WPA strives to develop young people for future leadership roles, pork industry involvement, and career success, and offering these scholarships is a great way to provide opportunities and demonstrate our support of youth and our commitment to the future of the pork industry.

4-H and FFA youth are eligible to apply for a \$100 scholarship used to offset costs associated with their 2025 pig project. Our goal is to raise enough funds to award a minimum of 50 scholarships. Scholarships will be divided into three age divisions, as of January 1st, 2026, including: Ages 9-11, 12-15, and 16-19.

Criteria:

Youth who are selected to receive a WPA Youth Pig Project Scholarship will be asked to participate in a 30-minute educational webinar to receive their \$100 scholarship check. Those who do not participate will not receive their scholarship. The Wisconsin Pork Association is committed to youth development and feels that offering resources like these will help further educate youth about swine production and other opportunities within the industry. Webinar dates will be announced at a later date.
